Agricultural Property Classification for Property Tax: What It Means

Recently it has came to our attention that our members have been affected by certain property tax classifications that happened in 2017. We want to help clarify that provided a nursery meets the definitional test contained in the Iowa Code, it should be classified as agricultural property for property tax purposes.

To meet this definition, the primary use of the property must be agricultural - according to Iowa code land will be classified as agricultural property if "its principal use is devoted to the raising and harvesting of crops or forest or fruit trees, the rearing, feeding, and management of livestock, or horticulture, all for intended profit." Nurseries produce agricultural farm products and are defined under Iowa law as such. Keep in mind that there can only be one classification per property and properties are classified according to present use "not according to any highest and best use."


> In the meantime PWG is urging pest management professionals to be exceptional stewards of pyrethroids.


