## **BASF Releases New Spray Control Programs**

BASF has introduced four new, targeted fungicide rotation programs that will help nursery and greenhouse growers protect their ornamental crops throughout the plant production cycle.

The BASF Foundational Fungicide Programs include recommended products, rates and intervals to help control a variety of key plant diseases. Intrinsic brand fungicide, which is the foundation of these programs, also promotes growth efficiency and greater plant tolerance to environmental stressors.

#### The four programs include:

- Poinsettia Propagation Spray Rotation is designed for root development and transplant stages, which helps plants develop stronger feeder roots and better overall rootballs.
- Unrooted cuttings and seedlings includes Pageant<sup>®</sup> Intrinsic brand fungicide. Treated cuttings exhibit faster callousing and greater number of root initials, which helps plants get off to a good start. The diseases controlled

## **Two New Ornamental Pest Management Tools by OHP**

OHP recently added two new crop protection tools to its profile of biosolutions. One of the products is Thuricide N/G Biological Insecticide, which is derived from a naturally occurring bacteria and infects lepidopteran larvae and other insect larvae. Thuricide N/G contains the bacteria Bacillus thuringiensis subspecies kurstaki strain SA-12.

Thuricide N/G is the latest of several additions to the OHP biosolutions segment of new tools for crops grown in greenhouses, nurseries, and the landscape — including

vegetables and herbs. Thuricide N/G is approved for organic production and is Organic Materials Review Institute listed.

Use of Thuricide N/G fits well into a pest control program utilizing beneficial insects or predators, says Dr. Carlos Bográn, OHP Technical Manager.
