Testing Day & Time: June 20, 2018 | 9AM—12PM

Any individual who did not successfully complete the ICNP examination in February are able to take a re-examination in June. If an individual passes either the plant identification or written portion of the exam, that passing score is good for one year. For re-examination, you only need to take the portion you did not pass.

2018 Farm Bill

The House Agriculture Committee has just released its version of the 2018 Farm Bill. The Committee is scheduled to consider the bill on April 18, 2018.

"AmericanHort commends Chairman Mike Conaway on his efforts to draft a 2018 Farm Bill that addresses key priorities for specialty crops and horticulture, and to begin debate on this critical piece of legislation," said Craig Regelbrugge, AmericanHort senior vice president for advocacy and research. Essential elements in the bill include research and innovation initiatives as well as pest prevention and disaster programs that provide basic infrastructure and support, much the equivalent of 'municipal utilities and services,' for our industry.

The legislation sustains and builds on sound policy for our industry, and the provisions most important to horticulture enjoy the support of most Ag Committee Republicans as well as Democrats. "Our leading members were passionate advocates for these programs when they met with Congress last fall, and we are pleased at the progress," said Tal Coley, AmericanHort Director of Government Affairs.

However, the bill's path forward is somewhat uncertain due to provisions unrelated to farm and specialty crop policy that are controversial, and may lead to difficult debate and votes along party lines. Farm bills are typically enacted with broad bipartisan engagement and support, and we are hopeful that the dialogue and bipartisan cooperation seen in previous Farm Bill debates will ultimately prevail.
