## **Governor Reynolds Joins President in Roundtable Discussion**

Iowa Governor Kim Reynolds joined President Trump, Secretary of Labor Alexander Acosta and seven other governors at the White House today for a roundtable discussion that touched on a wide range of workforce-related topics.

"In Iowa, we have a diverse and growing economy, even with some significant challenges with agriculture and the flooding. But we have the lowest unemployment rate — 2.4 percent. We have more lowans working than any other time in our state history," noted Gov. Reynolds during the roundtable discussion.

"And here's the other part of the narrative, I think, that nobody has mentioned yet: We've had seven straight quarters of wage growth in the state of Iowa, and a lot of blue-collar workers are experiencing that...not only are we bringing people off the sidelines, but we're seeing wages increase too, and that is just a win-win.

So as I travel the state, here's the other good news: Because of the politics that you've put in place, every job creator that I talk to, they are projecting significant growth moving forward. They're very optimistic about the future. And what an opportunity for lowans," continued Gov. Reynolds. The lunch-hour meeting with the President, members of his administration, and a bipartisan group of governors highlighted federal and state efforts to reduce barriers and expand economic mobility for America's workers.



In public remarks prior to the meeting, President Trump welcomed the governors to discuss occupational licensing reform, advancing childcare policies and providing quality job training to all Americans.

Other attendees included Governors Doug Ducey of Arizona, Brian Kemp of Georgia, David Ige of Hawaii, Mark Gordon of Wyoming, Chris Sununu of New Hampshire, Tom Wolf of Pennsylvania and Bill Lee of Tennessee.
