student at Iowa State University.

High character, financial need, leadership, and scholarship. For a student who is majoring in Horticulture and planning a career in the landscape, nursery, and/or garden center business. A student must have completed two semesters of work. The Iowa Nursery and Landscape Association scholarship committee and the ISU Department of Horticulture will make the selection.

According to the discussion between members of the Association and the University, the following criteria have been established:

- Any student who has completed at least two semesters of work in the Department of Horticulture and who is majoring in Horticulture and planning a career in the landscape, nursery, and/or garden center business, can be considered a candidate for the scholarship.
- Any student that will graduate in December will be ineligible.
- Any student that has received a previous INLA scholarship will be ineligible.
- The Department of Horticulture will screen candidates and prepare necessary background information.
- The INLA Scholarship Committee shall meet at a specified time in the fall of the year to interview candidates. The final selection will be made by the INLA Scholarship Committee.
- The person selected will be notified and asked to appear at the INLA Conference and Trade Show held the last week of February in Ames, Iowa. One payment of \$2,000 will be made to the student.
